Objective

Unit 1: [15 Hours]

Three Act Structure; Understanding Three Act design –two film analysis; Deconstruct the Three Act structure of a film or play;

Submission - Analysis of the Three Act structure of a film

Unit 2: [5 Hours]

Conflict: need of conflict and how to develop it – one film analysis;

Unit 3: [10 Hours]

Step outline: introduction. *Identifying events and make a step outline using the Two Act design, using the premise developed in Semester III and develop a step outline for it (group activity)*

Submission - A step outline of the premise developed in Semester III.

Unit 4: [10 Hours]

Subtext: understanding subtext, various forms of subtext – 2 film analysis

Unit 5: [10 Hours]

Dialogue writing; Understanding the dynamics of dialogue writing. The 3 functions of dialogue. Two-man two space. Have 2 characters and create a dialogue between them using conflict, exposition and characterisation.

Submission - Script of two-mantwo space

Unit 6: [10 Hours]

Adaptation: analysis of a short story and its film adaptation.

Unit 7:[30 hours]

Choose a short story, adapt it to screen. Create a premise, Make a step outline, have character sketches, write dialogues, have subtext.

Submission - A short film script
