

WHEREAS JNC affiliated to the Bengaluru City University, offering quality education by conducting versatile undergraduate and postgraduate programmes since 1966, equipping students to achieve greater goals by training them to obtain placements and career progression

WHEREAS Swasti Vishwa Institute for Behavioural and Social Sciences Institute is committed to provide world class learning opportunities to individuals, organizations and communities in the areas of behaviour and social science to create transformation.

WHEREAS both institutions are of the opinion that mutual cooperation and sharing of resources would be beneficial for the academic and extracurricular growth and development of students of both institutions

WHEREAS both parties have held discussions and therein agreed upon collaboration for enhancing the academic quality of both institutions,

THEREFORE, both parties had an initial discussion for identifying the areas of collaboration and operation methodologies, and arrived at a consensus:

1. Areas of cooperation: -

- a. Providing training / internship for Postgraduate students
 - i) Advanced Training in Clinical Psychology.
 - ii) Practical experience.
- b. Academic Resource Sharing: It involves
 - i. Sharing Databases and e-resources.
 - ii. Initiating Academic Forums and engage faculty from both institutes as resource persons.
 - iii. Organizing Collaborative Workshops/ Seminars / Conferences.
- c. Research: It initiatives would involves -
- i. Undertaking Minor Research Projects.
- ii. Academic writing /Publishing Research articles.
- iii. Sharing laboratory resources.
- iv. Executing collaborative projects.
- 2. All programmes or activities implemented under the terms of this Memorandum of Understanding shall be mutually agreed upon.
- 3. A Core Team will to be formulated before the implementation of the programmes mentioned under this MoU, and the document in this regard shall be part of this MoU. The Core Team shall have the Heads of both the Institutions as the General Convenors, and a Coordinator of various programmes listed in this document.
- 4. The Core Team shall meet biannually to streamline the processes.

- 5. Any financial requirement for proposed activities or remuneration toward fee for internships that may arise will be borne by the beneficiaries of the activities or Interns
- 6. A certificate will be given stating a participant has successfully completed a programme or an Internship which will be signed by heads of both Institutions provided the participant has fulfilled the criteria for considering a programme or Internship as successfully completed by heads of both the institutions.

Period of MOU:

This Memorandum of Understanding will become effective on its signing by the representatives of both Jyoti Nivas College Autonomous and Swati Vishwa Institute for Behavioural and Social Sciences Institute for a period of Two Years and is subject to revision or modification by mutual agreement.

Settlement of Disputes:

- 1. This Memorandum of Understanding may be amended by a written agreement signed by the representatives of both parties.
- 2. In the event of any unforeseen incident during collaborative activities both the Parties agree to negotiate a mutually acceptable solution.
- 3. Should any disagreement arise out of the application, interpretation or implementation of this agreement, the parties shall endeavour to exercise best efforts to settle their differences. Termination:

This agreement may, at any time during its period of validity, be terminated by either party upon six months' prior notice to the other in writing.
