## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

3) Information rights: Airways Aviation shall have customary

4) Intellectual Properties: For clarity, and as a condition of agreement

the parties acknowledge& agree that Airways Aviation Academy is the globaloperator owned by United

Management DWC-LLC Part of the Riana Group of Companies) and that the name and brand 'Airways Aviation' is owned exclusively by United Management DWC-

LLC.

5) Approvals: Each of the Parties shall use their

reasonable efforts to obtain (supervisory board, shareholders and/or third party) consents, approvals and permission, and the Parties shall co-operate to obtain consents, approvals and permission of any governmental authorities required for the consummation.

6) Costs

- The Parties shall each bear the costs, charges and expenses in relation to the negotiation, preparation, execution and implementation of this MOU, the Agreement and the documentation contemplated thereby.
- Cost AAA will incur- instructor's salary.
- Cost JNC will incur- Printing of flyers and marketing material, social media, email blasts or any other local marketing, printing of the supplied study material and certificates for the students.
- Revenue will be split between the two parties.
- Students will be making the payment of INR 2500 to JNC either through online transaction, bank transfer or cash payments.

Terms and conditions and financial split between Airways Aviation Academy (AAA) and Jyoti Nivas College Autotnomous (JNC).

 Students will be making the payment of INR 2500 to JNC either through online transaction, bank

transfer or cash payments.

 JNC will provide the classroom, admin assistance and recruitment assistance for the course.

The revenue generated will be equally shared between Airways Aviation Academy and Jyoti Nivas College Autonomous. (INR 1250 for each student)

Confidentiality

The Parties shall keep confidential, the existence of thisMOU and their further negotiations, as well as confidential information obtained by them in relation to their respective businesses, but which they shall be allowed to disclose to their professional advisers, or to any authorities if required by law.

**Duration and Termination** 

This MoU will be 12 months from date of signing and will be automatically renewed unless terminated. It can be terminated by either party with one month's written notice.
