- Jamming Process:
- When a participant notices a rule violation, they must immediately call "Jam!"
- The lowest-scoring participants are eliminated.

- Evaluation Criteria: The Jam Master will assess based on:

Articulation & Flow: Ability to speak fluently without unnecessary pauses.

Confidence & Control: Handling interruptions effectively.

Content & Relevance: Staying on topic and maintaining engaging speech. Quick Thinking: Seamless recovery from potential jams.
