- Research paper should Include the following in the order mentioned (Title, Author, Affiliation, Abstract, Keywords, Main Text, Acknowledgements (If any) Appendix and References)
- Full paper length should be around 7000 words.
- Line Spacing :1.5 and Margin 1 Inch on all sides
- Citation should be as per APA 6th edition
- Maximum two Authors are allowed for each paper: at least one author needs to be registered for the conference to get their paper considered for presentation
