Minutes of the Meeting

The Institution's Innovation Council (IIC) meeting was conducted on 28 June, 2025 at 11.30am in the Botany lab and the following points were discussed.

Agenda of the meeting

1. Quarter 3 and quarter 4 activities of IIC.

Highlights of the meeting

1. President of IIC, Dr. Priyadarshini Pillai welcomed all the members and discussed the agenda of the meeting. The meeting began with a review of the IIC calendar for Q3 and Q4 (2024–25). It was agreed that pending Q3 activities may be completed in Q4 to ensure timely execution and reporting.
2. Dr. Priyadarshini opened the discussion by urging all departments to actively contribute and explore additional activities that align with IIC mandates. She reminded us to refer to the Excel sheet she had circulated and post department-specific contributions in the group by July 5.
3. Ms. Bella proposed conducting a training session on “How to Prepare a Business Plan” via hybrid mode, allowing flexibility for both online and in-person participation. This would address the Q3 activity requirement for *Business Plan Development Workshops*. She also suggested that organize a 1-day integrated event with multiple sessions, including:
A session by the Startup Centre Committee on “*How to Start a Startup*”, which would include a hands-on session by Ms. Sajna, entrepreneur and founder of SkinNeeds, sharing her startup journey, a workshop by the IPR Cell on “*IPR in Startups*” and a panel discussion with all resource persons. All the members agreed that this program would be meaningful and should be completed before August 2025.
4. In terms of competitions, Dr. Bella suggested that the MBA and MCA departments jointly conduct a Business Plan Competition, fulfilling a Q4 IIC deliverable and encouraging collaborative innovation among students.
5. Dr. Shilpa Abhang shared that students from her department present innovative project presentations as part of their curriculum. Recognizing its value, Dr. Bella mentioned that these could be documented under *prototype development* and that details should be uploaded to the Yukti portal by June 30, 2025.
6. A visit to an Atal Incubation Centre as part of the Q4 activity calendar was also planned. Christ Deemed to be University and Dayanand Sagar Institutions were suggested as

potential options. This visit will give students direct exposure to startup ecosystems and must be organized before September 2025.

Outcomes of the Meeting:

1. A one-day integrated program featuring sessions on *Startup Basics*, *Entrepreneurship Journey*, *IPR in Startups*, and a panel discussion will be conducted by August.
2. A joint Business Plan Competition will be hosted by the MBA and MCA departments as part of Q4 activities.
3. Innovative projects from students, particularly those related to prototypes, will be uploaded on the Yukti 2.0 portal by June 30.
4. All members will review and post extra departmental activities in the IIC group by July 5, based on the Excel tracker shared by Dr. Priyadarshini.
5. A visit to an Atal Incubation Centre (Christ or Dayanand Sagar) will be organized before the end of Q4.
