Jyoti Nivas aims to motivate and enhance research potential among staff and students to promote innovative, intellectual and creative thinking. Every year the Research Cell of Jyoti Nivas brings out two issues of *Academic Studies: National Journal of Jyoti Research Academy*, one online research journal *Navajyoti* and one edition each of students' research journals: *The Researcher*, *Scientia*, *Samshodhana*, *The Notebook* and *Dhii*.

Several departments bring out their annual newsletters to record their achievements and endeavours. The students of the Centre for Media Studies produce short films, documentaries and regularly bring out campus newspapers.

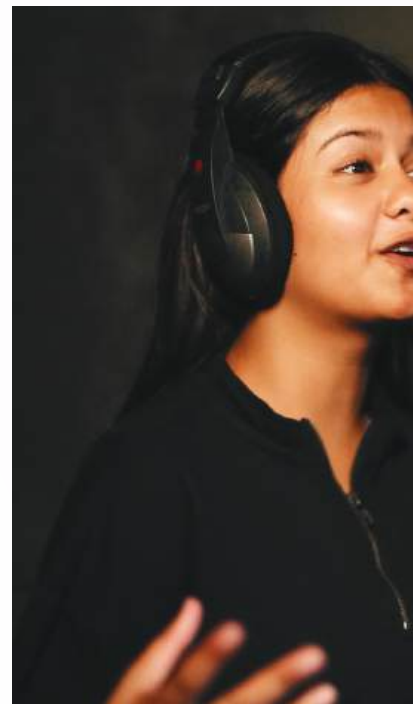
PG Eligibility

MA in English

Graduates who have secured 40% in the aggregate of all subjects and 50% (45% for SC/ST and category I candidates) marks in the cognate subject in the qualifying University examinations are eligible. Candidates with BA, B.Sc, BCom, BBA, and BCA degree are eligible provided they have scored 55% marks in the Language concerned in the degree course.

MA in Media Studies with specialisation in (i) Visual Communication and Generative AI or (ii) Advertising and Digital Marketing

Graduates who have secured 40% in the aggregate of all subjects and 50% (45% for SC/ST and category I candidates) marks in the cognate subject in the qualifying University examinations are eligible. Candidates with BA, BSc, BCom, BBA, and BCA degree are eligible provided they have scored 55% marks in the Language concerned in the degree course.

Bachelor of Science (BSc)

LIFE SCIENCES: The discipline of Life Sciences consists of all fields of science that involve the scientific study of living organisms, including plants, animals and humans. Life Sciences include the departments of Botany, Zoology, Genetics, Biotechnology, Biochemistry, Psychology and Chemistry. These combinations foster creative thinking, enhance practical knowledge and develop problem-solving skills in students. The courses are designed to improve understanding of research and development, acquire knowledge, and promote a multi-disciplinary approach to Life Sciences.

PSYCHOLOGY (SINGLE MAJOR)

- Candidates must have studied Psychology as a subject in any stream, or must have completed their 12th/PUC education in the Science stream, as recognized by Bengaluru City University.
- Minimum of 60% marks for Karnataka students and 70% marks for outside students (aggregate) in the qualifying examination.

MASTER OF SCIENCE (BIOLOGICAL SCIENCES):

- BSc graduates with at least 40% marks in the aggregate of all subjects and 50% marks in the aggregate of all optional subjects, with any three of the following subjects: Chemistry, Bio-Chemistry, Botany, Applied Botany, Zoology, Applied Zoology, Environmental Science, Microbiology, Biotechnology, Genetics, Applied Genetics and Sericulture, are eligible.

MASTER OF SCIENCE (COUNSELLING PSYCHOLOGY):

- Candidates must have completed an undergraduate degree with a minimum aggregate of 50% from a UGC-recognized university (India or abroad).
- Candidates currently in the final year of their undergraduate programmes must have a minimum aggregate of 55% across all completed semesters.
- Individuals who have completed their undergraduate studies and are currently employed are also eligible to apply.

MASTER OF SCIENCE (PSYCHOLOGY)

- Applicants must have completed an undergraduate degree with Psychology as one of the core subjects, securing a minimum overall aggregate of 50% (and 55% in Psychology) from a university recognised by the UGC (India or abroad).
- Candidates currently in the final year of their undergraduate programmes must have a minimum aggregate of 55% across all completed semesters.

School of Physical Sciences

Bachelor of Science (BSc)

The discipline of Physical Sciences is expanding rapidly. This discipline comprises the departments of Physics, Mathematics, Electronics and Computer Science. All the combinations are designed to enable the students to face the challenges of the future with confidence and also obtain rewarding careers in the respective fields. The curriculum keeps abreast of the latest advancements in the respective domains and endeavours to produce humanists and scientists of high calibre and commitment.

- Minimum of 50% marks for Karnataka students and 60% marks for students from outside Karnataka (aggregate) in the qualifying examination.

MECS, PME, PMCS, PJCS

- The minimum qualification required to apply is a pass in the 10+2 examination in Science from PUC / ISC / CBSE or an equivalent board with Physics, Mathematics, Chemistry and Electronics/ Biology/ Computer Science as core subjects as required by Bengaluru City University.
- Minimum of 50% marks for Karnataka students and 60% marks for students from outside Karnataka (aggregate) in the qualifying examination.

BCA, BCA-DS

- A candidate who has completed II PUC or 12th Standard (CBSE/ISC) or an equivalent qualification from any recognised board and has studied Computer Science/ Mathematics.
- Minimum of 60% marks for Karnataka students and 70% marks for students from outside Karnataka (aggregate) in the qualifying examination.

Master of Computer Applications (MCA)

The two-year Master of Computer Applications (MCA) programme provides industry-oriented education in applied computer science, combining strong theoretical foundations with specialized tracks in Data Science, AI & ML, Cybersecurity, or Full-Stack Development. The curriculum emphasizes continuous practical training and includes a mandatory industry internship, preparing graduates for successful IT careers. Students develop comprehensive programming skills, analytical thinking, and problem-solving abilities essential for modern technology roles.

Eligibility

- Candidates must hold a BCA/Bachelor's degree in Computer Science, Engineering, or equivalent discipline, or a B.Sc. (any combination)/B.Com./B.A. degree with Mathematics at 10+2 level or graduation. A minimum of 50% marks in the qualifying examination is required.
- Candidates must qualify through one of the following entrance exams: PG CET (conducted by Karnataka Examination Authority) KMAT (conducted by Karnataka Post Graduate Private Colleges' Association).

MSc in Mathematics

The Master of Science (M.Sc.) in Mathematics offers an in-depth exploration of both pure and applied mathematics, providing students with the skills needed to tackle complex problems across various fields. This programme is perfect for those looking to pursue careers in academia, industry, or research, equipping graduates with valuable analytical, problem-solving, and critical thinking skills sought after in sectors like Data Science, Engineering, and Finance.

Eligibility

- Graduates who have secured 40% marks in the aggregate of all subjects and at least 50% marks in Mathematics (cognate subject) at the degree level are eligible.

MSc in Computer Science

The M.Sc. Computer Science programme offers specialized tracks in Data Science, AI & ML, and Cybersecurity, providing comprehensive knowledge of advanced computing concepts with a strong emphasis on data-driven technologies, artificial intelligence, machine learning, and cybersecurity. Students gain practical expertise in designing, developing, and deploying intelligent and secure systems for real-world computing environments. Through a balanced integration of rigorous theoretical foundations, hands-on projects, collaborative team activities and a mandatory research or industry internship, the programme delivers industry-aligned education that prepares graduates for advanced careers in the tech industry.

Eligibility

- B.Sc. (Computer Science) or BCA with Mathematics as one of the subject and at least 50% aggregate marks of all optional subjects (throughout 3 years B.Sc. / BCA course), B.Sc. PCM with PG Diploma / Certificate in Computer Science of duration one year from a recognized university.

Master of Science (Organic Chemistry)

The Masters in Organic Chemistry is a two year full time course spanned out into four semesters. Organic chemistry plays an essential role in a large number of chemical industries. The objective of this programme is to provide students with an advanced knowledge of organic chemistry. The course is designed to gain strong knowledge in Chemistry with practical applications of theory leading to research in Organic Chemistry and inter-disciplinary projects related to Chemistry.

Eligibility

- Graduates who have secured 40% marks in the aggregate of all subjects and at least 50% marks in Chemistry(cognate subject) at the degree level are eligible.

School of Commerce

Bachelor of Commerce (BCom)

The programme aims to impart quality education to young women who wish to pursue their career in the field of commerce. The syllabus aims at developing analytical skills and knowledge pertaining to Accounting, Marketing, Human Resource, Business Law, Banking, Finance and Taxation which are both traditional and computer based. The programme enriches the students to gain knowledge and to be aware of the obligations as responsible citizens in their respective fields.

Eligibility

- Students who have completed a two year pre-university course in Commerce (with Business Studies and Accountancy) of Karnataka State or any other equivalent courses, are eligible to seek admission to the BCom Degree programme.
- Minimum of 60% marks for Karnataka students and 70% marks for students from outside Karnataka (aggregate) in the qualifying examination.

Bachelor of Commerce: Travel Management (BCom TM)

Tourism is one of the largest industries in the world. As an industry, tourism is a highly complex phenomenon as various disciplines are involved in it. The programme aims to provide knowledge and perceptive skills in relation to business and tourism related activities with an exposure to social, economic and legal environment. It also empowers a student with the concept of marketing and its role in the promotion of tourism products.

Eligibility

- Students who have completed a two year pre-university course in Commerce (with Business Studies and Accountancy) of Karnataka State or any other equivalent courses, are eligible to seek admission to the BCom TM Degree programme.
- Minimum of 50% marks for Karnataka students and 60% marks for students from outside Karnataka (aggregate) in the qualifying examination.

Bachelor of Commerce: Logistics and Supply Chain Management (BCom LSCM)

The programme focuses on equipping students with all the knowledge and expertise in dealing with the corporate world covering International Logistics, Supply Chain Management, Warehouse Management, Economic Analysis and Contract Negotiation in Logistics. Presently the job market is opening up with several opportunities in the field of logistics which in turn would empower the women students.

Eligibility

- Students who have completed a two year pre-university course in Commerce (with Business Studies and Accountancy) of Karnataka State or any other equivalent courses, are eligible to seek admission to the BCom LSCM Degree programme.
- Minimum of 50% marks for Karnataka students and 60% marks for students from outside Karnataka (aggregate) in the qualifying examination.



Bachelor of Vocation (Banking and Finance)

The B.Voc in Banking and Finance programme is designed to provide students with the skills, knowledge, and practical exposure required for careers in banking, financial services and related industries. It equips the students with practical and theoretical knowledge of banking, financial and investment management.

Eligibility

- Students who have completed a two year pre-university course of Karnataka State or equivalent, are eligible to seek admission to the BVoc (Banking and Finance) degree programme.
- Minimum of 50% marks for Karnataka students and 60% marks for students from outside Karnataka (aggregate) in the qualifying examination.

Bachelor of Commerce (Business Data Analytics)

The Bachelor of Commerce (Business Data Analytics) is an interdisciplinary undergraduate programme that combines core commerce disciplines with specialized training in data analytics to prepare students for data-driven business environments. The programme builds strong foundations in accounting, finance, marketing, economics and management, alongside skills in statistical analysis, business intelligence, data visualization and analytical tools. Through practical learning, case studies and projects students develop the ability to analyze data, generate insights, and support strategic decision-making. Graduates will be well equipped for analytical and managerial roles across industries and for further studies in commerce, analytics, and management.

Eligibility

- Students who have completed a two year pre-university course in Commerce (with Business Studies and Accountancy) of Karnataka State or any other equivalent courses, are eligible to seek admission to the B.Com Business Data Analytics Degree programme.
- Minimum of 60% marks for Karnataka students and 70% marks for students from outside Karnataka (aggregate) in the qualifying examination.

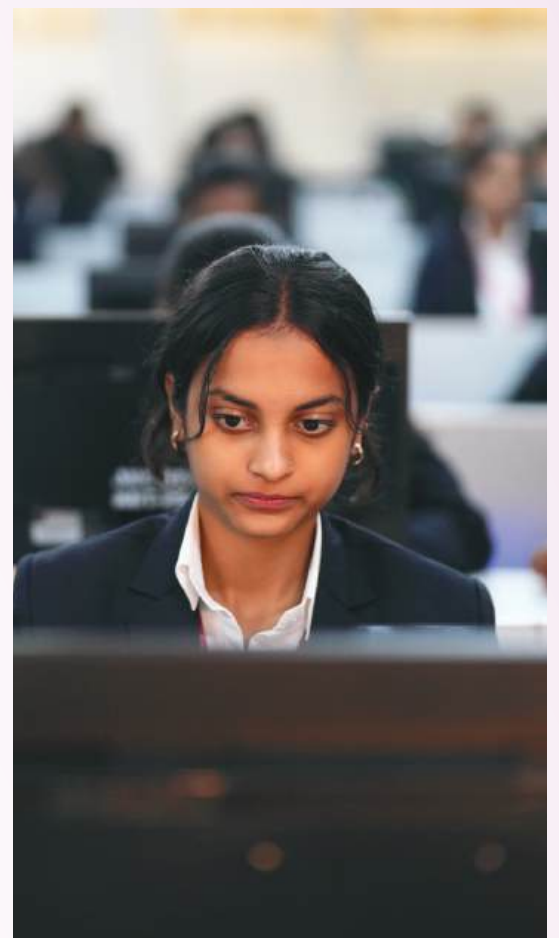

Master of Commerce (Financial Analysis)

The programme is designed to give both theory as well as practical inputs so that the students are more competent in terms of placements. The programme also helps the students use their financial management and taxation knowledge, not only from the employment perspective but also enables them to prepare a perfect financial plan for themselves. The Department guides the students to excel in the field of capital investment, e-commerce and auditing, in order to be proficient in any type of organization they join. The objective of the M. Com (FA) Department is to develop and enhance the accounting and financial management skills in the areas of Auditing, Taxation, Information Systems and Financial Analysis necessary to function effectively within private businesses, non-profit organizations and public agencies.

Bachelor in Business Administration (BBA)

The Programme intends to impart business management skills to young women. It aims in preparing students to take up challenging careers in business and industry.

- Minimum of 60% marks for Karnataka students and 70% marks for students from outside Karnataka (aggregate) in the qualifying examination.

Master of Business Administration (MBA)

The MBA programme at Jyoti Nivas College, Autonomous is a full-time, two-year course structured across four semesters. - Candidates who have passed Bachelor's Degree (10+2+3) of Bangalore City University or any recognised University, in any subject in Commerce, Management, Arts, Social Science, Sciences, Engineering / Technology or equivalent and have secured not less than 50% of marks in Bachelor's Degree Examination in aggregate are eligible for admission to this course.
- The eligibility for admissions will be based on the aggregate of the Bachelor's Degree marks and Entrance Test Marks (KMAT/CMAT/PGCET) or any other National Eligibility Test (50:50)

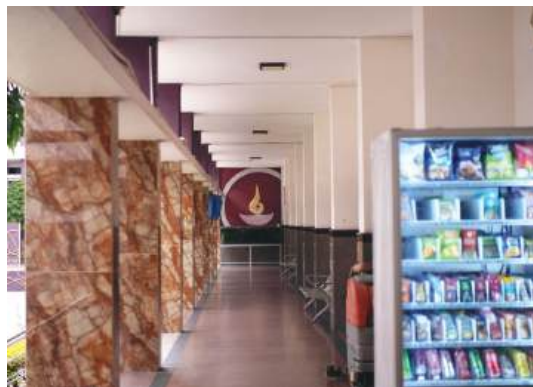
Campus Facilities

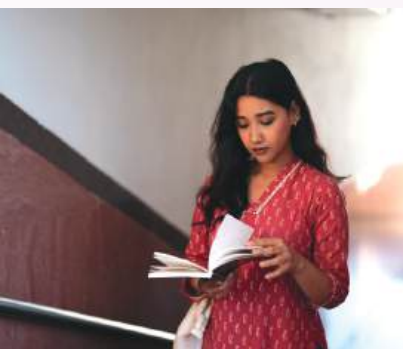
