Grammar: indefinite articles, the gender of nouns; Present tense of verbs ending in ER, verbs avoir, apprendre; negation; irregular adjectives. Verbs “avoir and Etre”, interrogation, negative form, and prepositions.

Savoir –faire: talking about one’s city, telling what one likes, giving information, expressing admiration, asking for directions and indication of the weather.

Grammar: Definite articles, Present tense of verbs ending in ER; adjective, RE verbs, and adjectives.

Savoir – faire: saying what one’s taste is and one’s profession, characteristics of a person, introducing the family and announcing an event.

Grammar: verb conjugations, Possessive adjectives, Articles, and Pronouns.

Savoir – faire: Asking for time, everyday routine, Inviting, accepting, expressing one's inability to attend.

Grammar: reflexive verbs, indication of time, imperative mood, past tense.
